From March 11 - 17, Laura and the dancers will be in rehearsal on the LMU Strub Theatre stage, working with multimedia artists from NightLight Labs who are creating special video projections.

Invertigo is thrilled to once again partner with Loyola Marymount University on the development of this piece. The creation process of this work began with a rehearsal intensive in July 2017 and another in May 2018, both of which took place at LMU. This final intensive marks the culmination of a work that is based on the life and work of Alan Turing, the WWII code breaker and father of artificial intelligence. As the development phase of this work comes to a close, we are more excited than ever to share it with you.
